



Firework Safety

- Never hold lit fireworks in your hand.
- Never lean over fireworks or use near the face – and never point or throw fireworks at anyone.
- Do not relight fireworks and be careful when picking up used fireworks – they might still be hot.
- Never ignite fireworks in glass or metal containers, which could explode or shatter
- Keep a bucket of water or hose close by to douse duds and to use in case of a fire.
- Don't experiment with homemade fireworks.
- Avoid having fireworks land on people, houses, and vehicles.



If a burn injury occurs, know these simple steps and take immediate action:

- Run cool – not cold – water over the burn.
- Remove all clothing and jewelry from the injured area.
- Cover the area with a dry, clean sheet or loose bandages.
- Seek immediate medical attention.
